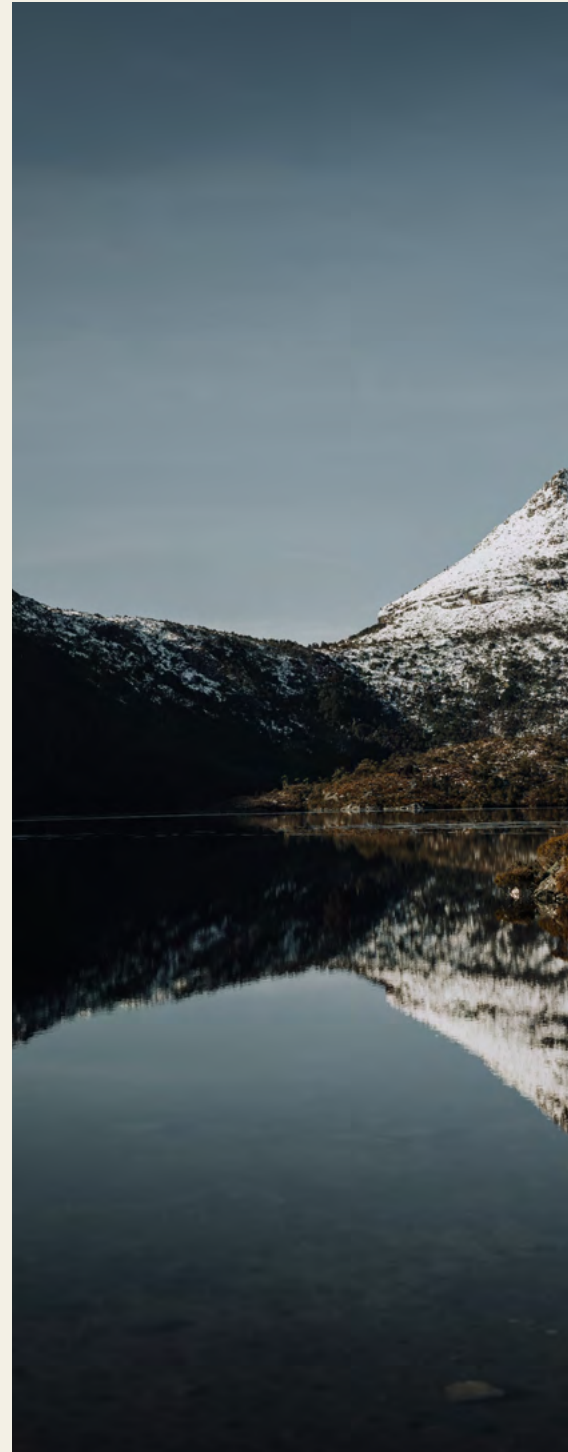

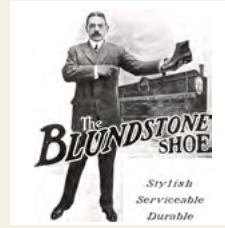




A history of never standing still

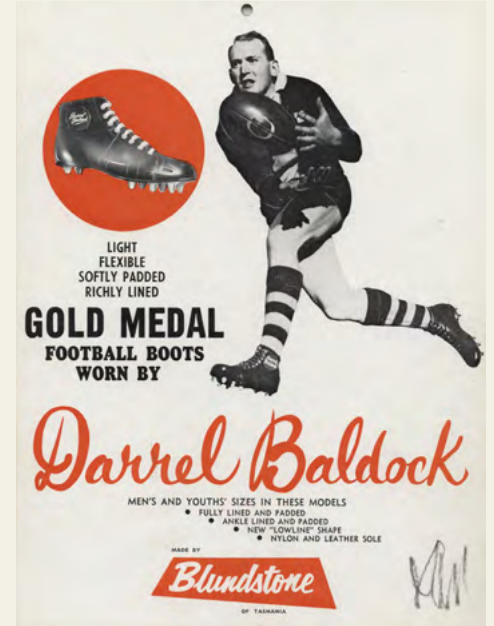
Our story began back in the 1850s when the Blundstones sailed from England to the colony of Hobart, Tasmania, and set about establishing a business to supply the young colony with fit for purpose footwear.

In 1870 the Blundstone business was founded and the first factory opened. Right from the start Blundstone boots were known as trustworthy products that could be relied upon no matter how hard you worked, no matter what life threw at you.



The first boots were hardy, hobnailed, lace up styles designed to stand up to the rigours of colonial life. They were put to the test by not only workers in the cobbled street city, but pioneering farmers and factory workers as well. Not content with just looking after workers' feet Blundstone also made baby slippers, children's school shoes and women's dress boots.

Testament to the strength and durability of our boots Blundstone was contracted to supply boots to the Australian Army in World War 2. Over 500,000 military-grade pairs were made for Australian troops, and we are told the American troops tried to swap them for their own.



After the war we set about designing new styles of boots, expanding our range to meet changing industries and lifestyles. We produced boots for smelter workers, boots for forestry workers and even the Australian Football League.

And to top it off our boots made it all the way to Mount Everest as the first Australian Everest expedition team chose Blundstones to help make their way through the Himalayas. After the expedition their Sherpas were so impressed by the resilience of the boots in such harsh conditions that they asked to keep them.



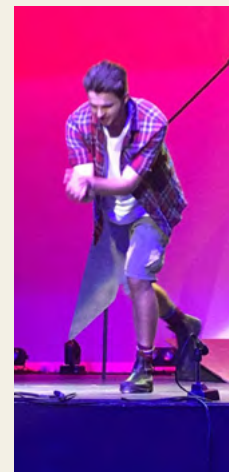
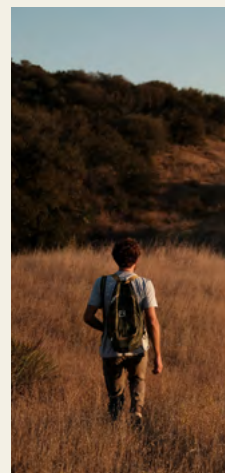
In the 1960s we began exporting into the Pacific and by the 1990s the world was knocking on our door so we opened up export to the northern hemisphere; Italy, Sweden, Canada and Israel being pioneering markets for our boots from down under. The whole world then got to see us on stage at the 2000 Sydney Olympic Games, when the world renowned Tap Dogs danced their socks off at the opening ceremony wearing customised Blundstones.

Driven by continued growth we have become a truly global brand, manufacturing in six sites around the world, one still being Hobart, and with our sales outside of Australia outstripping those at home.



It has been almost 150 years since a small shoe manufacturer set out to create the finest boots they could to serve the tiny remote colony of Tasmania. Today Blundstone remains a family owned business and the dedication and passion to keep making the best boots continues to drive us day in and day out. To never stand still.

Blundstone continues to stand for reliability, honesty and hard work, and it's why our boots are worn and loved all around the world.

Designed to work

And our commitment is more than boots. We are also helping to invest in the next generation of agriculturalists through rural scholarships, community support and other programs.

We've designed specific safety boots for loggers, miners, smelter floors, mountain climbers and soldiers. We're always up for a challenge, and we'll always do our bit to protect working feet.

We've worked closely with those who sell, buy and wear our boots, to understand and design for shifting needs, challenges, environments and lifestyles.

We continue to push ourselves to innovate, and in 2015 we were recognised with a Good Design Award for our underground mining boot.

We're even part of a team working to change the management of diabetic conditions, through innovation in footwear technology. If boots can help, we want to make sure we're a part of it.

Our boots aren't just safe, stylish and long-lasting—they're also incredibly comfortable.

We take great care in designing boots with comfort firmly in mind, and we're proud that so many people prefer to spend a day on their feet in a pair of Blundstones than anything else.

Walking your own path

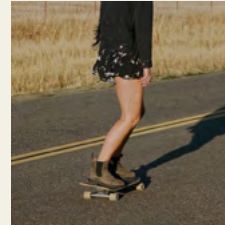
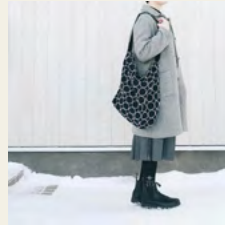
Freedom, confidence, independence and adventure: things that are important to our customers, and important to us here at Blundstone.

And we couldn't be prouder to be helping them get on with it.



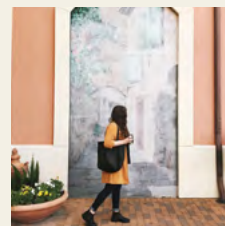
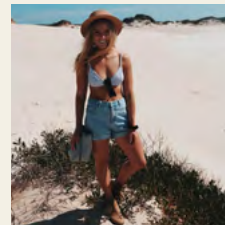
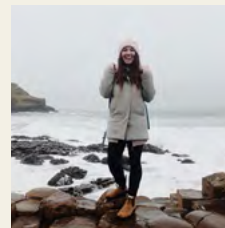


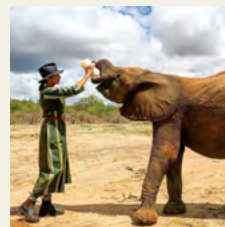
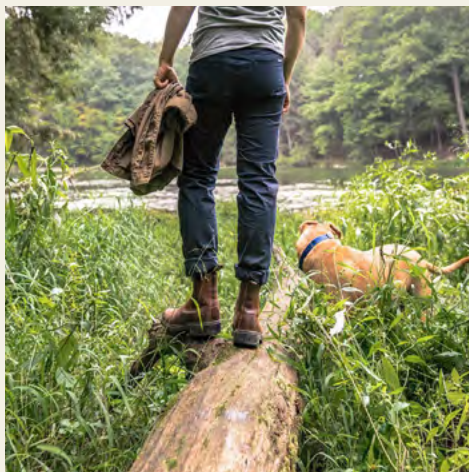
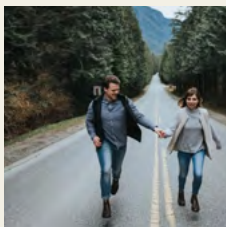
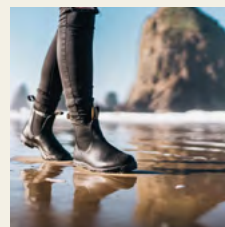
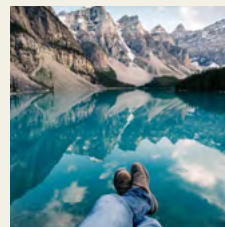
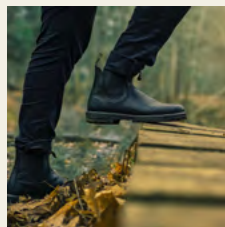
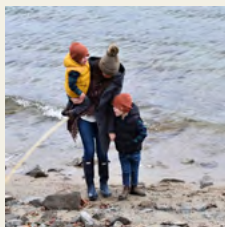
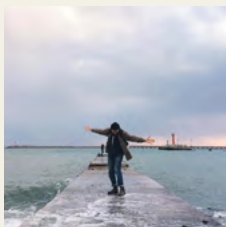
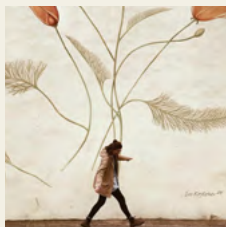


Our community

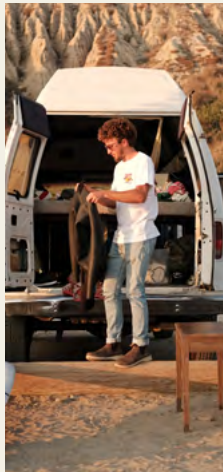






Life your way
